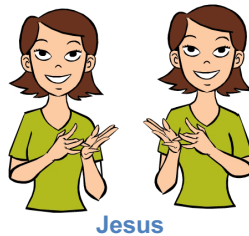

This is David. We can find David's story in 1 Samuel 16. David was a child of God just like us. God was looking for a new King to rule the land. God told Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance, for I only look at the heart." This is exactly what we should do to everyone around us.

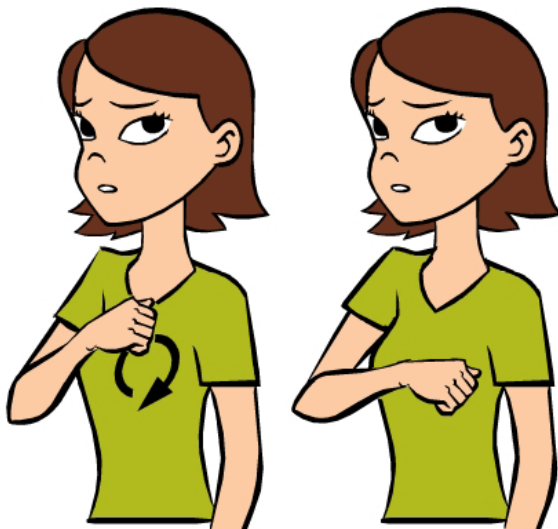
