NEWS FROM ROME (Italy)

Rome, November 9, 2023

Dear brethren in Him,

my wife Antonella and I hope to find all of you doing fine in every possible blessing from God. We wish to express our deepest feelings of thankfulness for all that you are doing in our behalf, giving us the opportunity to preach the gospel also in Rome, the Capital of almost everything that goes against God's Will, where Bible ignorance and human materialism are the dominant characteristics that influence every side of our society. Obviously, all this makes our spiritual efforts harder and harder. Anyhow, we'll be trying to do our best in reaching out whosoever is interested in God's word.

PERSONAL NEWS. We're all doing pretty good, thanking God. Our daughter Valeria and her family are doing well and our three grandchildren (Alessandro almost 9 years old, Alice 7 1/2, Samuele 4) are joyfully growing in all good things. We always try to give our contribute in helping Valeria as much as possible with the kids job.

Our son Paolo is also doing fine. We don't see him as much as we would like, but he's really busy with his flight assistant job in Milan.

LOCAL PREACHING ACTIVITY. Our local work is going on fine. We just met this week to talk about our future activities, trying to plan the work as good as possible. We want now to be mostly concentrated in the preaching work, after a moment of internal discussions and solving problems. The unity and strength of the congregation are our first goal to achieve and protect. We hope and pray to be always enough wise and responsible to realize this important focus.
