The beginning of Psalm 22 is the ancient passage Jesus quoted with some of his final breaths—"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" In fact, foreshadows of the cross are all over Psalm 22.

- "All who see me mock me; they make mouths at me; they wag their heads; 'He trusts in the LORD; let him deliver him; let him rescue him, for he delights in him!" (22:7-8)
- "I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint; my heart is like wax..." (22:14-15)
- "They have pierced my hands and feet-I can count all my bones... they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots." (22:17-18)

And yet, for some reason, David was moved by the Spirit to write about what would happen after such a horrific ordeal.

- "I will tell of your name to my brothers; in the midst of the congregation I will praise you." (22:22)
- "The next generation will be told about the Lord. They will come and declare his righteousness; to a people yet to be born they will declare what he has done." (22:30-31)






