




Evolutionary Model of Geology/Fossils	What is Found in the World
Oldest rocks on the bottom	Oldest rocks are not always on the bottom
Primitive life forms in oldest rocks	Complex life forms in the oldest rocks
Younger rocks contain complex life forms	Simple life forms in the youngest rocks
Gradual change from simple to complex	Sudden appearance of all life forms (simple/complex)
Large numbers of transitional life forms	No transitions forms (sharp boundaries between forms)
